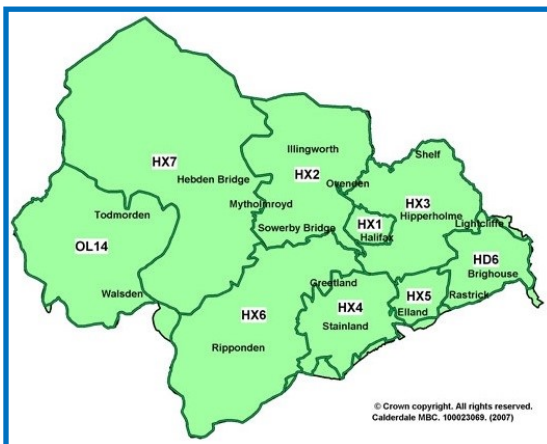

Our information and support service promotes choice and provides people with a voice. **The service is run by and for disabled people.**

We are based in Hebden Bridge but support people with disabilities and long-term health conditions throughout the Calderdale district.



# Services we offer

We offer ‘person-centred’ support, with issues that people with disabilities and long-term health conditions face in their daily lives, such as:

## Benefit issues

- Attendance Allowance;
- Carer’s Allowance;
- Children’s Disability Living Allowance (CDLA);
- Employment and Support Allowance (ESA);
- Personal Independence Payment (PIP);
- Universal Credit; etc.

## Housing issues

We support people who use our service in the following ways:

- We offer a voice to the people we support;
- We signpost the people we support to other organisations where appropriate;
- We help secure peoples’ rights.
- We are not able to offer advice; we are able to offer **information only**.
- We offer support with accessing services.

**We offer tribunal preparatory work, but we do NOT offer representation.**

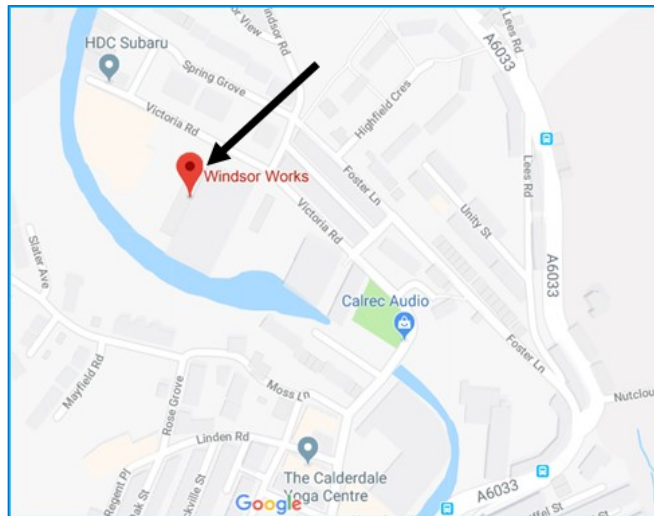
